**Required Documents for Resident and Panamanian Passports –Forest Law**

- 1- Special Power of Attorney for our law firm to handle your immigration paperwork.
- 2.-Certification of title of the reforested land, or copy of the buy/sell contract
3. - Photocopy of valid passport of the applicant (and dependents - if applicable), including the picture page (that shows the picture, name, date of birth, passport number, place of issue, etc.), and all pages showing entry/exit stamps (all pages used in the passport).
4. - Original Police record, from the place of residence of the applicant  
And spouse.
- 5-Original Birth Certificate (applicant and depends)
- 6.-Original Marriage Certificate
- 7- Six (6) passports sized photographs of the applicant and dependents.
- 8- Certificate of Good Health, issued by a licensed Panamanian hospital or clinic, signed by a registered, licensed physician, indicating that the applicant and dependents has no contagious diseases and is in good mental and physical condition. This must be done during your initial visit to Panama.
- 9- HIV Test results of the applicant and dependents - done by a licensed Panamanian laboratory, showing negative results. This must be done during your initial visit to Panama.

Fees: Legal Fee - US\$1,500.00

Government Fees: US\$800.00

For Dependents (spouse and children under 18 yrs):

Legal Fee - US\$1,000.00

Government Fees: US\$800 .00

After the one year the authorities provided you with a Panamanian Cedula (Permanent Resident Card). And after 5 years of having Permanent Residency status, you may apply for Panamanian Citizenship.
